- Personal statement

- Personal statement of 500 words or less answering the following two prompts:
 - ► Describe your involvement in efforts to advance diversity, equity, and inclusion within the community and/or legal profession, including during college, law school or otherwise.
 - ► Discuss any unique skills, perspectives or insights that you believe you will bring to the legal profession due to your background and/ or experiences.

Additionally, to be considered for the scholarship, you must separately apply for a position in our 2025 Summer Associate Program by completing an <u>application form</u>.
