Alston* on college athlete name, image, and likeness (NIL) rights, as well as the future of college athlete compensation, which will be significantly impacted by the outcome of the *House v. NCAA* case in which Jeffrey is co-lead counsel.

“By allowing individual conferences to regulate,” Jeffrey said, “we [would] get to the correct economic outcome—where the athletes that generate huge revenues get to partake in those revenues.”
