#### **KEY TAKEAWAYS**

- There is a significant amount of liquidity for warehouse lines, with non-bank entities entering the space and absorbing what has been displaced by some banks withdrawing from warehouse lending
- Borrowers should take an active role in understanding their lender's balance sheet and nurture their funding relationships so that they can anticipate market shifts
- The simplicity of multi-asset facilities should be weighed against fee structure, cross-commitments and defaults, covenant management, and operational concerns
- Basel III regulations and their implementation have created instability, with price increases going hand in hand with structural changes that have largely led to increasing costs for borrowers
