This raised the question: What new types of disputes are emerging in this landscape?

Additional topics discussed included:

- Strategies to safeguard company interests amid resource nationalism, environmental regulations, and phase-out processes.
- Emerging disputes linked to the increasing use of technology in renewable energy projects.

The event also celebrated the remarkable contributions of women driving innovation and excellence in arbitration, featuring dedicated networking opportunities throughout the day.
