KEY TAKEAWAYS

- There is increasing division amongst courts on whether, and to what extent, courts can consider merits-related issues (such as the lack of injury to every class member) at the class certification stage.
- One option for defendants to consider is whether merits-related defenses as to the named plaintiff(s) give rise to typicality and/or adequacy arguments.
- Separately, claims fraud and improper claims aggregation are on the rise, and parties need to protect against increasingly sophisticated schemes.
